The Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center Community Care-A-Van is a free, mobile medical unit staffed by Medical Center health care professionals.

- Primary medical care, Immunizations, Acute Care, Physicals, and Health Education
- Testing for Syphilis and HIV
- Referrals for WIC
- Pregnancy Testing and Referrals for Prenatal Care

A bilingual English/Spanish-speaking representative always is present on the Care-A-Van.

Services are targeted to uninsured children and pregnant women who do not have a regular source of medical care. All services on the van are free of charge.

When you come to the Community Care-A-Van, please bring any immunization records for your children being seen. We will also need demographic information on those being seen, including age, a current address, phone number, etc.
