West York Limited Partnership has requested that Baltimore County Public Schools grant a permanent easement to Baltimore County Government to allow for the relocation of a 24 inch storm drain line onto the northeastern edge of the Carver Center for Arts and Technology property. The relocation of this storm drain piping and the associated easement is contingent upon West York Limited Partnership meeting all Baltimore County Government requirements associated with proposed piping relocation. In addition, the limited partnership is requesting approval of 35-foot wide temporary construction easement along that portion of our property that adjoins their property.

At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities recommends approval of the permanent and temporary easements along the northeastern edge of the Carver Center property.
