

Fee Acceptance for Design Services for Systemic Renovations at
Dundalk Middle School
February 12, 2002

On December 4, 2002, the Board of Education granted approval for the Department of Physical Facilities to enter into negotiations with the firm of Kovacs, Whitney and Associates to provide consultant services for the systemic renovations planned for Dundalk Middle School. These services include the preparation of the design, construction documents, and assistance in the bidding phase of the project. The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a not-to-exceed fee of \$600,000.00 with the consultant to provide these services.

At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities recommends acceptance of the negotiated fee with Kovacs, Whitney and Associates to provide the design services associated with the systemic renovation at Dundalk Middle School. Funding for these services is available from Capital Budget Project #665 - Major Maintenance.
