**Recommendation for Award of Contract
Fire Alarm and Sprinkler System Upgrades at Deer Park Middle Magnet School
March 26, 2002**

On March 7, 2002, one (1) bid was received for upgrades to the fire alarm and sprinkler system at Deer Park Middle Magnet School - Bid #5-542-02. This project consists of adding additional fire alarm signals and pull stations, extending the sprinkler heads in the main lobby, adding a monitoring flow switch on the existing main sprinkler valve, and connecting the existing kitchen hood to the fire alarm system to meet code requirements. Based on the bid received, the Department of Physical Facilities recommends an award of the contract to Chilmar Corporation, Inc., the only responsive bidder, in the amount of \$83,143.00.

At this time, we are also requesting a 10% Change Order Allocation in the amount of \$8,314.00 to cover any unforeseen conditions and minor changes to the contract, to be authorized and approved by the Building Committee in accordance with Board Policy.

Funding for this project is available from the Capital Budget Project #080 – Deer Park Middle Magnet School.
