### **Recommendation for Fee Acceptance – Design Services for Performance Center at Carver Center for Arts and Technology March 12, 2002**

On March 12, 2002, the Board of Education granted approval for the Department of Physical Facilities to enter into negotiations with the firm of Hayes Large Architects to prepare a study and preliminary planning for a performance center and exhibition hall at the Carver Center for Arts and Technology. This performance center will include a 500-seat auditorium with a fully equipped stage, technical booth, and fly loft equipped with state-of-the-art lighting, sound and technical apparatus. The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a not-to-exceed fee of \$250,000.00 to provide the necessary architectural and engineering services.

At this time, we request approval of the negotiated fee with Hayes Large Architects in the not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000.00 to prepare a study and preliminary planning for the performance center and exhibition hall at the Carver Center for Arts and Technology. Funding for these services is available for State Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2002.
