RECOMMENDATION

That Board of Education Policy #2350 be deleted. The current language is unnecessary because adherence to fire safety code and regulations is already mandated in the Annotated Code of Maryland and in Life Safety Code. In addition, compliance protocols and standards are delineated in the Baltimore County Public Schools *Emergency Procedures and Safety Manual*.

ADMINISTRATION: Administrative Operations

Emergencies

Principals shall take every precaution for the safety of students and employees under their jurisdiction. Each school shall maintain an up-to-date set of rules and regulations for fire and disaster drills, said rules to be submitted to the Superintendent of School for approval.

Each principal shall have conducted at least ten emergency drills per school year and submit a monthly report on this activity.
