**Request for Fee Acceptance - Design Services for Fire Alarm System  
at Stoneleigh Elementary School  
June 11, 2002**

In the process of obtaining an occupancy permit for the new cafeteria addition at Stoneleigh Elementary, the Fire Marshal would only issue a temporary occupancy until a new fire alarm system was installed throughout the entire school. The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a fee of \$23,036.90 with the firm of E-B-L Engineers, Inc. to prepare a design for the new fire alarm system. E-B-L Engineers, Inc. prepared the electrical design for the cafeteria addition and is also one of our current on-call mechanical/engineering firms.

At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities requests approval of a negotiated fee in the amount of \$23,036.90 with E-B-L Engineers, Inc. to provide design services necessary for a new fire alarm system at Stoneleigh Elementary School. Funding for these services is available in the Capital Budget Project #089 – Stoneleigh Elementary School Cafeteria Addition.
