**Request for Fee Acceptance
Inspection Services for Subdivision of Open Spaces
and Science Lab Renovations – Chesapeake High School
August 13, 2002**

In order to provide for daily construction inspection services during the final phase of renovations to the open space areas and science rooms at Chesapeake High School, the Department of Physical Facilities requests approval to utilize the Baltimore County Department of Public Works' on-call contract for construction inspection services. The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a not-to-exceed fee of \$28,968.65 to provide inspection services through December 31, 2002. This is a not-to-exceed fee where Baltimore County Public Schools will be invoiced only for the actual hours worked and associated expenses.

At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities recommends acceptance of a negotiated fee with DFI, Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of \$28,968.65 for inspections services at Chesapeake High School. Funding for these services is available in the Capital Budget Project #666 - Alterations/Code Updates/Restoration.
