On February 12, 2002, the Board of Education approved Grieves, Worrall, Wright and O'Hatrick Architects to provide consultant services for the systemic renovations planned for Golden Ring Middle School. At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities requests approval to utilize the services of this consultant to provide construction administration services in conjunction with the project. These services will include attending preconstruction and progress meetings, reviewing and approving submittals including shop drawings and schedules, reviewing requests for information, issuing proposal requests, reviewing and recommending change orders, reviewing and approving contractor's requests for payment, reviewing contractor's close-out documentation, and providing final completion documentation including as-built drawings.

The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a not-to-exceed fee of \$100,000.00 with Grieves, Worrall, Wright and O'Hatrick Architects to provide construction administration services at Golden Ring Middle School. At this time, the Board's approval of the negotiated fee is requested. Funding for these services is available in Capital Budget Project #665 – Major Maintenance.
