PERSONNEL: Professional

Activities: Tutoring

The principal of the school involved and members of his/her staff are to consult with parents and to advise them with regard to tutoring. While such service may be advisable for some few students, it should be recommended only after all the resources of the school system have been utilized fully and when it definitely is believed that the best interests of the student are being served.

Principals are reminded that no teacher regularly employed in a school shall tutor for compensation any student whom he or she is currently teaching. Secondary school principals should review Graduation Requirements for Public High School in Maryland, Maryland State Department of Education.

Questions about this procedure should be directed to the appropriate Area Superintendent.
