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# **2012 – 2021 Enrollment Projections**

## **Executive Summary**

**January 24, 2012**

Goal 8.5 of the *Blueprint for Progress* states: “The student enrollment projections will have a 99.0% accuracy rate.” The Office of Strategic Planning, Department of Planning and Support Operations, has consistently met this goal. Ten-year projections are essential in the planning process for budget, allocating staff, distributing resources, and planning capital projects.

The enrollment for Baltimore County Public Schools (BCPS) is projected to increase gradually through 2012 to 111,990. The greatest increase in enrollment is projected to be in the elementary student population. The increase in our student population is indicative of the economy and the public confidence in BCPS.

Projections are submitted annually to the county government’s Department of Planning and the Maryland Department of Planning for comparison to state projection baselines.

**Goal:** Baltimore County Public Schools' (BCPS) *Blueprint for Progress* Goal 8.5 states: "The student enrollment projections will have a 99.0% accuracy rate." The Office of Strategic Planning is proud to consistently meet this goal. For September 30, 2011, the accuracy rate was 99.89%.

**Purpose:** Accurate projections are essential for determining budget, allocating staff, distributing resources, and planning capital projects. Projections are based on official September 30 enrollment counts and are revised annually by the Office of Strategic Planning. Projection numbers are total headcount, not Full Time Equivelant (FTE). Therefore, at the elementary school level, a conversion is required to accurately compare projections to capacity.

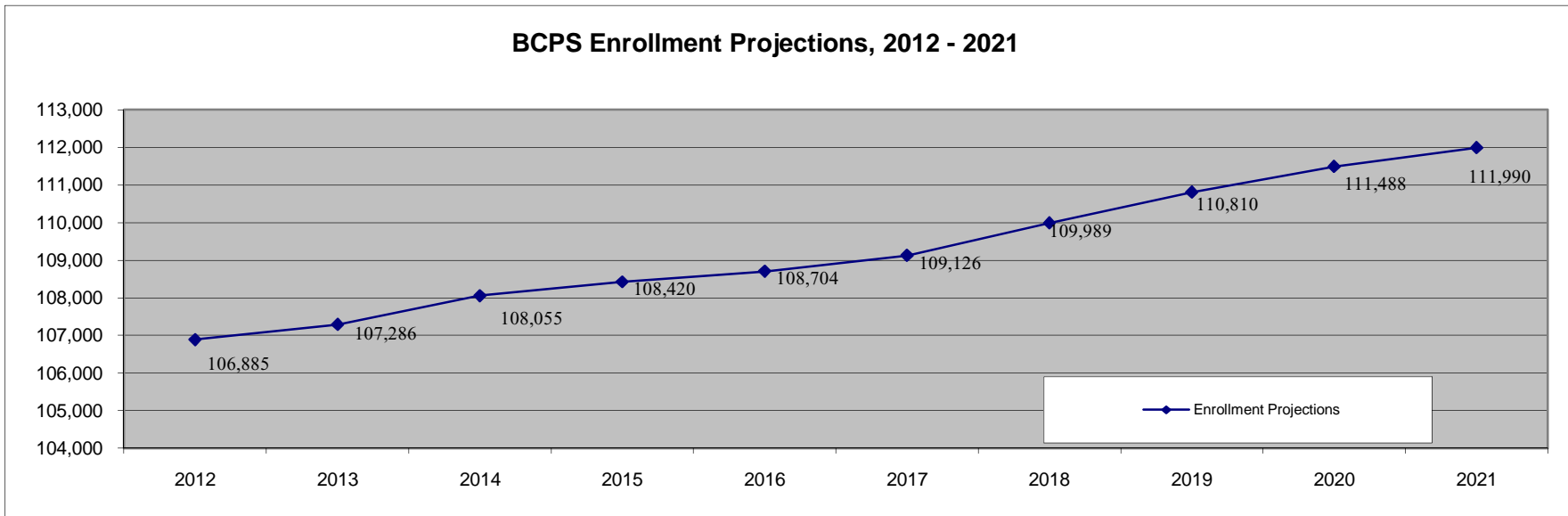
**Methodology:** The foundation of enrollment projections, as required by law, is Cohort Survival Methodology. It is the expectation that students matriculating through grade levels follow predictable and measurable patterns of graduating to the next highest grade level each successive year. Birth data, determined by trend analysis, is used to anticipate incoming kindergarten enrollments with a five year delay. Grade levels involving movement of students between schools (Grade 5 to Grade 6 and Grade 8 to Grade 9) are determined by trend analysis of each year's Grade 6 and Grade 9 feeder schools and projecting the trends onto current Grade 5 and Grade 8 populations. Other methodologies are also used to compare cohort survival to verify accuracy, including linear regression and Geographic Information System (GIS) analysis of student population and distribution.

For long range projections, consideration is also given to new housing construction and areas experiencing turnover of housing without children to housing with children. The Office of Strategic Planning meets regularly with the Baltimore County Office of Planning to share and discuss data and topics of this nature. Projections are submitted annually to the Maryland Department of Planning for comparison to state projection baselines. Projections submitted for the annual Education Facilities Master Plan must be within 5.0% of state baselines for approval to justify capital projects. For 2011 - 2020, BCPS' projections are within 5.0% for all 10 years of Maryland Department of Planning projections.

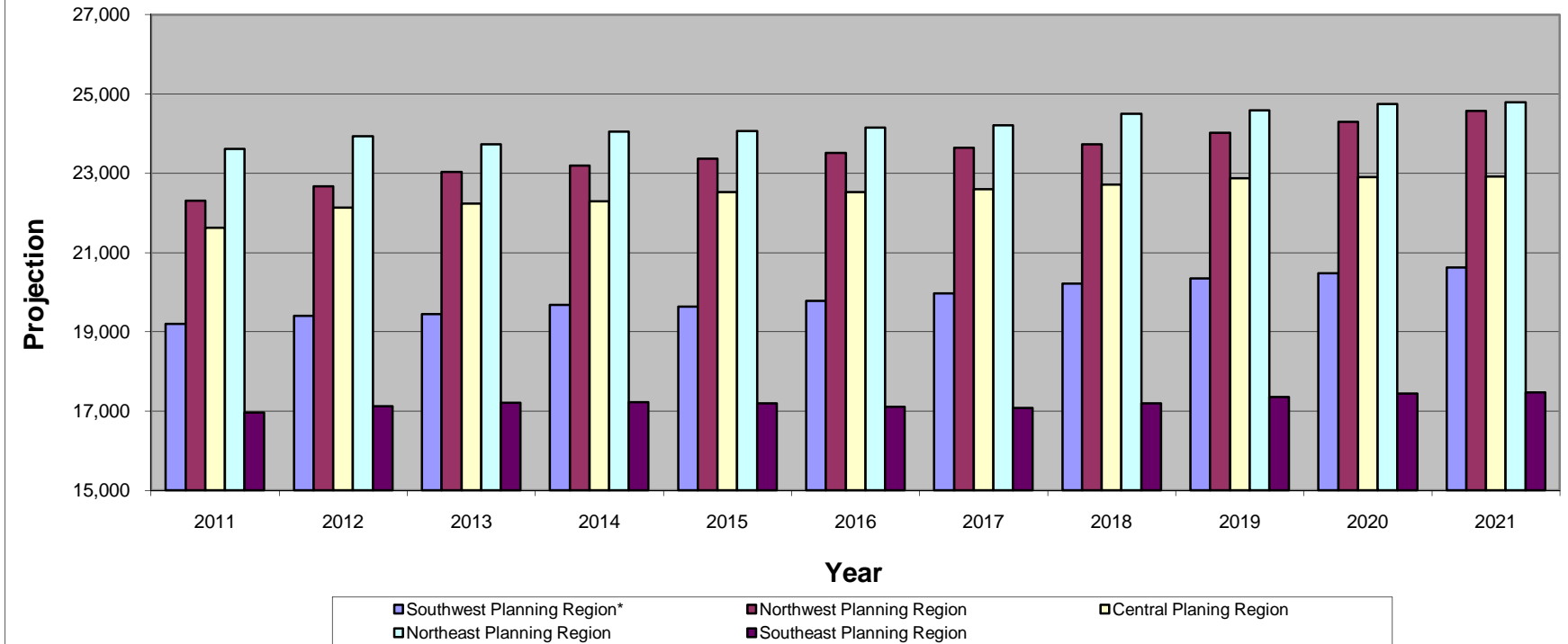
**Reporting:** The enrollment projection data is reported in two formats, by planning area and by administrative zone. This is to support consistency with previous years' projections and regional planning activities as well as the organizational administrative structure.

**Notes:**

- All schools offer full day kindergarten programs, or such programs are provided in cluster/annex/early childhood centers.
- Projections for Imagine Discovery Charter School are found on the Southwest Planning Area page, but are not included in Southwest Planning Area totals. Capacity is not included for Imagine Discovery since this space is leased and not owned by BCPS.
- Special Education schools and Other Schools are not projected by Cohort Survival Methodology. They are assumed constant from the most recent actual enrollment. These schools also do not reflect capacity based on their unique programs.
- A new George Washington Carver Center is under construction and scheduled to open in 2012. Capacity is estimated pending final approvals.
