**Description:**

- This contract modification will provide for continued implementation of the Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) program, which is a supplementary literacy program designed to reduce the gap between struggling students' current instructional reading levels and their expected instructional reading level.
- This contract modification will also provide for the expansion of the program to Grade 2 and 3 students, and will provide additional Grade 1 level kits for larger schools. It will also allow for the pilot of the secondary level kits to be used with the Grade 9 reading pilot program.
- The initial phase took place during the school year 2015–2016 for Grade 1 only, and benefited 600 students from 71 elementary schools.
- Seven elementary schools reported end-of-year data to reflect 84 percent of struggling Grade 1 students increased their instructional reading level by four levels or more to meet grade level expectations.
- These materials will be used for supplemental early intervention with struggling readers.
- Printed student and teacher materials will be purchased.
- The current expenditures on this contract are \$362,910.
- This material was discussed at Curriculum Committee on March 12, 2015.

**Method of Award Recommendation:**

This material was selected in accordance with Board of Education Policy and Superintendent's Rule 6002: *Selection of Instructional Materials*, and *Annotated Code of Maryland*, Education Article §7-106, *Textbooks, materials of instruction, and supplies*, Paragraph (a). On the recommendation of the county superintendent and subject to the provisions of this article, each county board shall adopt procedures for the selection and purchase of the following necessary items, at the lowest price consistent with good quality, for use in the public schools: (1) Textbooks; (2) Supplementary readers; (3) Materials of instruction; (4) Visual and auditory aids; (5) Stationery; and (6) School supplies.
