



Perry Hall Elementary School's Reopening Information

Arrival: 9:05-9:20 Dismissal 3:50-4:05

The staff of Perry Hall Elementary is excited to be back and to welcome our Gator family! The safety of our staff and students is most important and in place for everyone's return. We are happy to continue our rigorous and engaging instruction in the hybrid environment while committing to the social & emotional needs of our school community. We are here to help, if needed. **We are full of #gatorpride!**

Arrival & Dismissal Procedures:

- A student may be a bus rider-Student rides the BCPS school bus to and from school. Students will enter/exit at the front of the building.
- A student may be a car rider-Student is dropped off and picked up in the back car loop. Parents stay in the car and wear a mask. Students will enter/exit from the back of the building and wait in the hard-court area.
- A student may be a walker-Students walks to and from school OR parent parks on a side road and drops off/meets student at pavilion. Parents must maintain social distancing and wear a mask. Students will enter/exit from the back of the building.
- A student may ride a day care van-Student is transported by a day care van to and from school. Students will enter/exit from the back of the building.

Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:

- All employees and students are expected to screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19.
- **Remain home** if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results.
- Parents will receive a screening checklist and magnet with the screening practices.

Hand Hygiene:

- Times for handwashing or use of hand sanitizer to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools' offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and other time hands are contaminated.

Face Covering:

- **Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property.** Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses.
- Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged.

Social Distancing:

- Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, when possible.
- Reduce gathering of students in any area – refer to changes in arrival and dismissal procedures and movement in the hallways.

Breakfast & Lunch:

- Breakfast will be available to **ALL students, free of charge**. Breakfast "grab and go" bags will be available as students arrive and enter the building.
- Lunch will be available to **ALL students, free of charge**. Lunch will be a "grab and go" format. Water, snacks and a la carte items will NOT be available.
- Students will eat in the classroom at their desks and on alternative weeks, they will eat in the cafeteria. Students will be seated according to social distancing guidelines in both locations.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students with food allergies (related to breakfast/lunch) will be identified and students will be provided a lunch that meets their allergy needs.
<p>Supplies & Devices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> One supply list for the school has been created for both in-person and virtual learning. The list indicates items students should return and/or bring to school each day. Art supplies will be kept in individual boxes maintained in the classroom and carried to art class. Students should take home supplies on Tuesdays (Cohort A), Fridays (Cohort B) and whenever inclement weather is predicted <p>Students are expected to bring a charged device to/from school each day</p>	<p>Visitors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment. Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible. If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face covering and practice social distancing. The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.
<p>Attendance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attendance will continue to be taken in <i>FOCUS</i> daily Students are expected to attend ALL classes and small groups daily by logging in and participating in some way. If your child is unable to attend for some reason, please contact the teacher. Students will not be marked for lateness or for early dismissal 	<p>Safety:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Safety drills (fire drills, etc.) will continue and allow practice with each cohort When students return, safety drills will be planned and announced to teachers. Students working virtually will complete asynchronous work while in-person students participate in the drill Social distancing and use of masks will be required during all drills
