Senior Portraits:

All senior portraits must be taken by March 15, 2021. If you have not taken your Senior Portrait, please contact Lifetouch at 800-445-1189, to schedule an appointment. Portraits will be taken at the Lifetouch Studio, not at Woodlawn High School.

Yearbook Information:

- Senior yearbook photo selection must be selected through the Lifetouch online system. Proofs will be mailed to your home and will receive an online access code for you to log in, view the proofs and then select your yearbook picture. **Students must select a pose with either the Black Drape or Tuxedo Jacket for the yearbook.** Senior Portrait selections for the yearbook must be made by March 15, 2021.
- Seniors can purchase the yearbook through the BCPS online payment site. The cost of the yearbook is \$75 (Tax included). The process of ordering is two steps.
- Step 1: Each student must fill out an order form that can be downloaded from WHS website. This will provide us with your permanent mailing address where your yearbook will be shipped after graduation. Complete the form and once completed, you may email the form to Ms. Sanders at csanders2@bcps.org
