Wednesday 1/5/22 A Day	PLANNING DAYS: School will be closed for all students while teachers work to set up virtual classrooms and lessons. Students may use this time independently to access Schoology and catch up on missed work from before winter break, as needed.

Friday 1/7/22 A Day	LIVE VIRTUAL INSTRUCTION DAY: Students should log into Google Meets and engage in LIVE instruction for their classes. Attention should be given to the A/B Day schedule. Students should follow the virtual bell schedule below to access live synchronous instruction remotely from home. Virtual classroom links may be found on each courses home page in Schoology.

Dear Woodlawn High School Families:

Due to a school-wide COVID-19 outbreak and other critical factors (e.g., percentage of positive student and staff cases, number of staff, and students in quarantine, and special program considerations), Woodlawn High School will move to virtual instruction beginning Monday, January 3, 2022 until Friday, January 7, 2022. Consistent with the [Maryland Department of Health definition](#), five percent or more of unrelated students/teachers/staff (minimum of 10 of these individuals) at our school have tested positive for COVID-19 in a 14-day period. This decision was made after close collaboration with the Baltimore County Public Schools (BCPS) Office of Health Services.

We will resume in person instruction on Monday, January 10, 2022. The safety of our school community is our top priority and this **temporary switch** to virtual instruction will ensure that we limit the spread of COVID-19 in our school building and community. Please note that this period of virtual instruction is only five days due to the fact that staff and students have completed a portion of the 10-day isolation and quarantine period over the winter break. Please have your child(ren) login to Schoology at the start of the school day (7:30AM) for more information regarding virtual instruction. Details regarding our schedule for this week can be found in the attached document.

Meals will be available for students through curbside service at the main entrance. No sign-up or registration is required. Breakfast and lunch will be provided for all virtual instruction days. Meals will be distributed in the front bus loop from 11:00AM – 12:00PM on Monday, January 3, 2022 and Wednesday, January 5, 2022.

Important Notes for Virtual Instruction

- Teachers will use the Google Meet platform for instruction.
- Teachers will provide students with appropriate screen-time breaks.
- All teachers will use Schoology as the platform for communicating the class assignments, class resources, assessments and due dates.
- Students who have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), a 504 Plan or receive English Language Development services will receive instruction in the virtual platform.

Please continue to follow practices that minimize the spread of COVID-19 by physically distancing from others, wearing a face covering indoors, covering your coughs and sneezes with your sleeve or tissue, and washing your hands frequently. If you have not received a COVID-19 vaccine, please consider getting the shot as soon as possible. COVID-19 vaccines are available through the [Baltimore County Department of Health](#) as well as through many community pharmacies.

We understand that this change is disruptive for families and students, and we look forward to reopening our school building on Monday, January 10, 2022. Thank you for your continued
